

Terms, Conditions and Registration for Virtual TSS Classroom

In order for a student to participate in taking Traffic Survival School online, **you must read** and acknowledge the following:

1. To take this class online, STUDENT MATERIALS must be picked up from one of several sites in the Phoenix/Valley area. A list of these locations will be emailed to you. Student materials can be mailed to you (4-5 days locally/7-10 days if out of city or state) if you cannot pick them up.
2. The student must provide the following for the duration of the class **PRIOR** to class:
 - a. Reliable laptop, desktop or tablet with webcam and audio. NOTE: **Smart phones do not work** for this application. If you have technical issues, you will be asked to leave the class and reschedule for a physical class.
 - b. Reliable WIFI that will last on your device for the duration of the class whether it is the two-4 hour sessions or the entirety of an 8 hour session (plus 30 minutes for lunch).
 - c. The student must be in a quiet room or location that is free from interruption or distractions or any sort for the entirety of the class (see #6). This is a strict rule. Please do not put us in a position of asking you to leave the class because of it.
3. The student must register on acarefreetrafficsurvivalschool.com .
4. The student must **prepay on acarefreetrafficsurvivalschool.com** prior to the ZOOM invitation to join the class is emailed out. Click **Pay Now**, then look for the small box that says Pay with a Debit or Credit and follow the prompts.
5. If you are interrupted or leave the virtual classroom for more than 5 minutes, you could be removed from the class. If you need snacks or drinks have them prepared and in front of you prior to the beginning of class. You will have breaks and the 8 hour session gets a 30 minute lunch.
6. Zoom meeting is open to join 30 minutes prior to start of class. You must join the meeting then. At that time you will be placed in a "Waiting Room" until the teacher checks you. Be prepared to show your ID and student materials.
7. Cell phone use or other media is not allowed during the class. The Zoom meeting space for the class should be the only thing displayed on your computer or tablet. There should be no distractions.
8. All students of the virtual classroom must participate in any breakout partnering sessions requested by the instructor.
9. Students will not get ahead of the teacher in the workbook and will show their work as the teacher requests.
10. Students will abide by any requests or classroom procedure that the instructor gives you.
